The Center of Studies and Documentation of Egyptian Antiquities in Light of International Cooperation

ZAZH-Lecture with Dr. Hisham Elleithy

Founded in 1956, the Center of Studies and Documentation of Egyptian Antiquities (CEDAE) was first mandated to document the Nubian monuments threatened by submersion in Lake Nasser due to the construction of Aswan High Dam. Today, CEDAE has evolved significantly to document all the ancient Egyptian monuments, artifacts, and human and animal remains. To achieve its objectives, CEDAE has established cooperation and partnerships with leading international cultural and scientific institutions, including its historical partnership with the UNESCO and its relatively new collaboration with the Institute of Evolutionary Medicine, University of Zurich, in the study and documentation of mummies and human remains.

Dr. Hisham Elleithy is Under Secretary of State for Documentation of Egyptian Antiquities (CDEA), Ministry of Tourism and Antiquities.
